a. Collaborative Meeting: Healthy ageing in Israel and the UK: What can we learn from each other?

Participants: Members of ILC-UK and ILC-Israel, as well as experts from throughout Israel

Date: January 31, 2023

Plan: A collaborative meeting will be held at the Ben-Gurion University of the Negev involving members of ILC-Israel (lead: A. Mark Clarfield) and ILC-UK (lead: David Sinclair).

Full Description: This event will explore the state of healthy ageing in both countries. In particular, we will consider the policy landscape, examples of good practice and the challenges and opportunities (including solutions) to ensure that people live not only longer but healthier as well.

This consultative meeting will be an opportunity to present data from ILC-UK's Health Ageing and Prevention Index, and key healthy ageing data from Israel ESHEL. With both countries enjoying the services of well organized, (largely) not-for-profit, national systems of care, delivering high quality care to all age groups, this event will be an important opportunity to share best practice. There will also be an opportunity to hear from experts on what needs to happen next to ensure healthy ageing can be realized by all members of society.
